AppleColor RGB Monitor (IIGS): Converting for Use in Australia

TOPIC -----

Can the U.S. version of the AppleColor RGB Monitor (for the Apple IIGS) be converted for use in Australia?

DISCUSSION -----

To convert the domestic AppleColor RGB Monitor (IIGS) for use in Australia, both the power supply and CRT must be changed.

The power supply (domestic part #661-0348, international part #661-0358) needs to be changed for obvious voltage differences. The CRT (domestic part #076-0207, international-Australian part #076-0233) needs to be changed because the windings on the yoke are different. A domestic CRT cannot be realigned for use in Australia.

After both modules have been changed, the monitor needs to be adjusted (white balance).

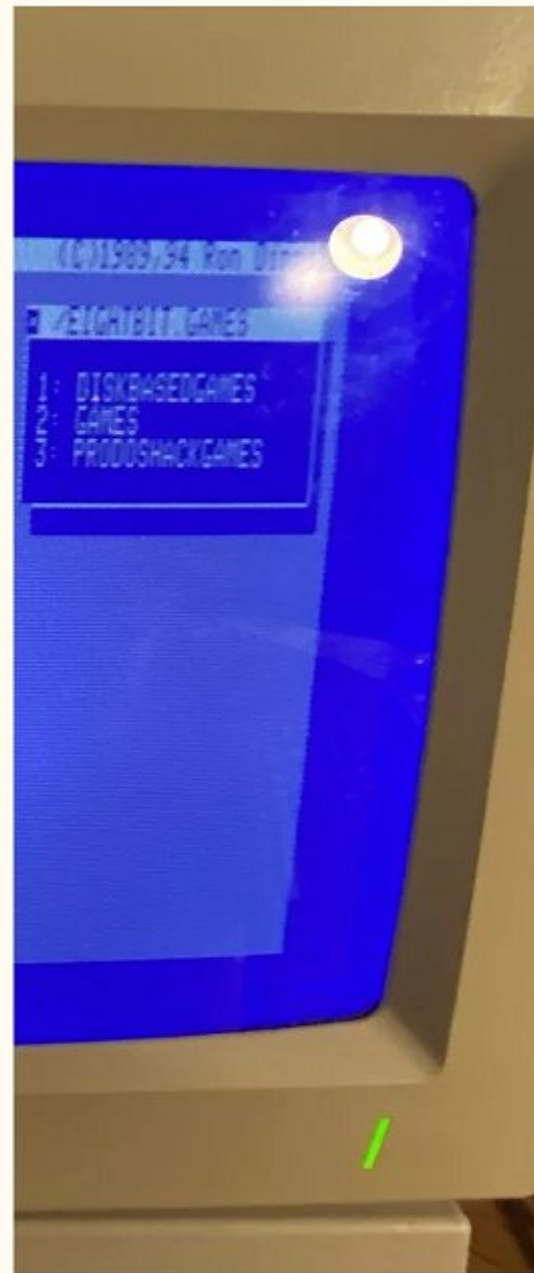
