

AppleColor RGB Monitor (IIGS): Converting for Use in Australia

TOPIC
Can the U.S. version of the AppleColor RGB Monitor (for the Apple IIGS) be converted for use in Australia?
DISCUSSION
To convert the domestic AppleColor RGB Monitor (IIGS) for use in Australia both the power supply and CRT must be changed.
The power supply (domestic part #661-0348, international part #661-0358) needs to be changed for obvious voltage differences. The CRT (domestic part #076-0207, international-Australian part #076-0233) needs to be changed because the windings on the yoke are different. A domestic CRT cannot be realigned for use in Australia.
After both modules have been changed, the monitor needs to be adjusted (white balance). Copyright 1992 Apple Computer, Inc.
